Sapienza University of Rome invites eligible researchers of any nationality to express their interest in applying jointly for a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Fellowships.

About Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Fellowships

Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Fellowships (IF) promote the mobility of researchers and provide opportunities to acquire and transfer new knowledge and work on research in a European context (EU Member States and Associated Countries) or outside of Europe. The grant provides a salary (minimum 12 months, maximum 24 months) and a mobility allowance, as well as covering research expenses and overhead costs for the host institution. Individual researchers may submit proposals for funding in liaison with a host organization. Further information about the IF call is available at:

Who Can Apply?

Researchers may be of any nationality and must have either a doctoral degree or at least 4 years full-time research experience. At the time of the proposal submission deadline, researchers must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in Italy for more than 12 months during the 3 years immediately prior to the submission deadline.

How to Express your Interest

As part of its mission to promote a research culture and an international research environment, Sapienza University of Rome invites eligible researchers to apply jointly for a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Fellowships (IF).
